**Re: Authorization of Train 1 Commissioning Cargo**

Dear Ms. Mahmoud:

I grant your February 24, 2016 request for Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC, and Sabine Pass LNG, L.P. (collectively referred to as Sabine Pass) to continue the commissioning of Liquefaction Train 1, including export of the produced liquefied natural gas (LNG) departing by ship today.

This authorization does not grant the approval of loading and export of any additional LNG produced during commissioning activities. Please provide further information detailing the expected amounts of LNG to be produced for the remaining planned commissioning activities, including the expected flow rate of LNG produced by the liquefaction train, the volume of LNG in each storage tank, and the approximate percentage of produced LNG relative to the amount of re-exported LNG that would be contained in each cargo.

I remind you that Sabine Pass must comply with all applicable remaining terms and conditions of the orders in the above referenced dockets, as well as procedures stipulated in your previous filings. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact Andrew Kohout at (202) 502-8053.
