34% reduction in Scope 1 GHG emissions intensity since 2016.

Significantly low methane intensity of 0.007%.

- Natural gas continues to play a significant role in the global energy mix and supports economies in the lower-carbon journey.
- Our LNG gives countries a source of energy that increases security and options, especially alongside the adoption of renewable energy.
- When displacing coal, our LNG can help improve air quality and reduce localized air pollution and public health risks around power generation sites.

Our vision is to provide clean, secure and affordable energy to the world. Cheniere is not only focused on meeting the challenges of today, but also those of tomorrow. In 2021, we made major strides on our environmental, social, and governance (ESG) initiatives, demonstrating leadership through our focus on being actionable, rather than aspirational.

In 2021, Cheniere received a rating of A (on a scale of AAA-CCC) in the MSCI ESG Ratings assessment.¹

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CLIMATE STRATEGY MILESTONES

Identifying climate risks and opportunities

- Completed a climate scenario analysis focused on transition risk to better understand risks and opportunities under future scenarios.
- Invested in research and development projects related to emissions measurement and mitigation across the natural gas supply chain.


Executing a strategy based on science and transparency

- Developed and published a first-of-its-kind, peer-reviewed life cycle assessment (LCA) of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions across our LNG supply chain.
- Launched a multi-stakeholder research partnership to support the development of our GHG quantification, monitoring, reporting and verification (QMRV) program.
- Installed emissions tracking systems on five LNG vessels to enhance our ongoing efforts to measure GHG emissions across the supply chain.

Integrating climate considerations into our business

- Linked executive and employee compensation to the successful execution of key elements of our climate strategy.
- Refinanced a \$1.25 billion revolving credit facility which includes features based on our commitment to address GHG emissions throughout our supply chain.
- Committed to providing estimated greenhouse gas emissions data associated with each LNG cargo to customers beginning in 2022.

Building on the foundation of our Climate and Sustainability Principles — science, transparency, operational excellence and supply chain — we are focused on measuring and mitigating emissions to strengthen the long-term resilience of our business.
