CALLOUT: Responding to a record-breaking hurricane season

In 2020, our emergency response teams responded to four hurricanes during one of the most active storm seasons on record. Hurricane Laura, a Category 4 event that occurred in August 2020, had the highest potential to impact our operations. Prior to the storm, Cheniere suspended operations at our Sabine Pass terminal and evacuated employees from our Sabine Pass LNG plant. We activated our emergency office location in Dallas to support the Sabine Pass IMT and placed our Corpus Christi IMT on standby. Within eight hours, we used our emergency alert system to confirm that all 500 plant employees were safe. A comprehensive assessment of the facility and its operations found that the hurricane had not caused any significant damage, with the facility performing as designed throughout the storm. We safely reinitiated LNG production at the site after operations had been suspended for only a week.
